Basingstoke & Deane Council	Items such as furniture, fridges, freezers, washing machines and televisions can be collected. Payments can be made in person or over the phone. A £10.00 charge will apply to those household items that a person would normally take with them should they move house and where the collection time does not exceed 15 minutes. Items of household waste that a person would not normally take with them when they move house, for example DIY waste, kitchen fixtures, fittings and internal doors, require a quotation. Elmbridge Borough Council	Items such as sofas, beds and domestic appliances can be collected. Items not for collection include clinical waste, building rubble and commercial waste. Collection is carried out within 5 working days on receipt of payment. Guildford Borough Council	Bulk items such as wardrobes and tables are collected at a small fee. Collection will be carried out within 7 to 10 days on receipt of payment. London Borough of Hammersmith and Fulham	Free collection of up to three items of unwanted household furniture or domestic appliances. There is a minimum four week period between each free collection per household. Items are collected within 24 to 48 hours on receipt of payment	This service is free of charge but must be pre-booked. If there are more than three items of furniture, domestic appliances, wood or garden furniture etc, this will be collected for modest charge. Quotations will be given on request. A visit may be necessary in some cases.
Hart District Council	Items such as furniture, fridges, freezers, cookers and carpets. Items not for collection include garden waste or builders rubble. Items are collected the next working day (excluding Wednesdays and Fridays) after payment has been received.	Minimum charge per collection is £22.50; large loads may be charged at a higher rate.
London Borough of Hilling don	Fridges and freezers and bulky items of household waste can be taken to any of the Borough's Household waste recycling centres. The Borough operates a special collection service for residents unable to take their items for a fee. Turn around for collection is two weeks once payment has been received. Hounslow Borough Council	A collection service for the removal of bulk items is available. Items are collected within 2 days if card payment is made over the phone or 6 days on receipt of cheque and postal orders.	A chargeable fee for £25 for upto 5 items and £5 for each additional item
The Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea	A collection service is available for the removal of refuse, such as furniture, carpets and cooker. An appointment is required prior to payment.	A flat fee of £20.50 (inclusive charge for up to ten items). There is no charge to residents in receipt of housing and/or council tax benefit. Items will only be collected from other levels, by prior arrangement, if the resident is elderly, disabled or there are other special circumstances.
The Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames	A collection service is available for bulk household items. An appointment subject to availability is required.	£20.00 for the first item with £5.00 for each item after that
Reading Borough Council	A collection of bulk waste is available to homes within the borough. Items are collected on a weekly basis.	Householders are charged £17.50 for the collection of up to five items that you would normally take with you when you move. Collections of six to 10 items will cost £22. Domestic fridges and freezers can also be collected for £17.50 per item. Senior citizens in the borough are entitled to two free collections of bulky waste per year. Free estimates for the collection of larger numbers of items, very large or heavy items are available on request.
Reigate & Banstead Borough Council	A collection service for items such as three-piece suites, beds, wardrobes, white goods such as washing machines and items that will not fit in a 140ltr wheeled bin. For residents on a hardship benefit, a restricted service can be provided.

The London Borough of Richmond upon Thame	A collection service from residential properties for bulk item is provided by the council. Runnymede Borough Council	A collection service for bulk items is available. Collection is subject to availability. Payment is required on completion of collection. London Borough of Sutton	A collection service is available to residents within the Borough. Collections occur weekly.	The bulky household collection team can call on a Saturday to collect anything 2 men can carry easily - typically old sofas. Currently there is a charge of £10 for up to 3 items.For anything heavier or more bulky, pianos, building waste and landscaping waste for example, there is a special collection from £42.Fridges and freezers are treated differently to ensure safe disposal of the environmentally dangerous refrigerant they contain. This is collected twice a week for £20.
Vale of White Horse District Council	A collection service is available for good quality furniture via Oxford Council for Voluntary Action. The council's contractors can remove bulk items such as dining room tables, settees and beds for a fee. Items are collected within 5 working days on receipt of full payment.	If you have to dispose of large items, the council's contractors can arrange this and there is a charge of £16.48 for up to 3 items and £5.50 per item after that. Alternatively residents can take up to three bulky items to the nearest waste and recycling centre and leave them for free. A £1.00 charge is made for each subsequent item.

Wokingham District Council	The council through its waste contractor, SITA, operates a service for collecting household items. Items are collected within 14 days on receipt of payment.	There is a £27 charge for each fridge/freezer to be collected. The fridges/freezers are collected separately from other items. This charge reflects the collection cost only. Concessions are available for the elderly or infirm.
