Housing Practice Certificate (Commencing September 2011)



The Thames Valley Housing Training Centre is running the **Level 2 Certificate in Housing Practice** qualification, starting in **September 2011**.

This qualification is targeted at housing assistants and tenants and acts as a relevant induction framework for employees new to the Housing Sector.

Start Date: 5th September 2011

Location: Twickenham

Time: 10:30am - 3:30pm (one session a week as outlined below)

Duration: 2 months

Cost: £978.66

The certificate covers the following core units:

- Unit 1 Housing Provisions and Housing Organisations
- Unit 2 Customer Care in the housing context
- Unit 3 Careers and Opportunities in Housing
- Unit 4 Developing Skills for Working in Housing

Training dates are as follows:

- Session 2 Monday 12th September 2011
- Session 3 Tuesday 20th September 2011
- Session 4 Monday 26th September 2011

The CIH Level 2 Certificate is an introductory vocational qualification for the housing sector, achievable through a short period of study.

As a Level 2 award, this certificate is broadly equivalent/comparable to GCSE (grades A-C), Scottish Standard Grades or an NVQ Level 2.

Level 2 Housing Practice Certificate is particularly suitable for:

- ⇒ People not currently working in housing but considering a front-line housing position as a career option
- ⇒ Tenants and residents wishing to explore housing issues to enhance their personal involvement and understanding of working issues
- ⇒ People who are new to housing or workers in a front-line position who want to improve their general awareness of housing issues
- ⇒ People working in housing who wish to attain an initial qualification in housing

Benefits to your organisation:

- ⇒ The programme will equip staff members with key skills and professional knowledge to enable organisations to perform more effectively in an increasingly competitive environment.
- ⇒ Successful completion of the programme will generate professional, competent employees who are better able to help organisations meet targets for audit and review.

Qualification Aims

- ⇒ To provide learners with a basic understanding of housing.
- ⇒ To introduce some of the skills and knowledge necessary to participate in housing related activities whether paid or voluntary.
- ⇒ To prepare learners for future study. Learners may progress to the CIH Level 3 certificate in housing Practice if they are working in housing.
